The Women's Leadership Network (WLN) creates opportunities for women to grow their business network, improve their professional skills, and learn from the experience of other accomplished female leaders.

WLN Education Series

Over 400 women and men assembled across North America to connect with each other and be inspired at **Women's Leadership Network events** held in Montreal, Los Angeles, Boston, Dallas, and New York.



The PLUS Foundation **WLN Luncheon at the PLUS Conference** in San Diego featured inventor and investor, Lori Greiner (Shark Tank, QVC), who spoke about her journey as an entrepreneur: pitching her ideas, growing her business, investing and supporting others, becoming a "shark" and, through it all, never giving up.



WLN Scholarship

\$5,000 scholarships are awarded to promising female leaders to advance their education and career. Over two years WLN Scholars engage in leadership programs, are paired with a PLUS mentor, get involved in regional WLN events, and are offered opportunities to network with PLUS and PLUS Foundation leaders. \$40,000 has been awarded to 8 women since 2019.
