Women's Leadership Network

The Women's Leadership Network (WLN) creates opportunities for women to network, improve their professional skills, and learn from the experience of other accomplished female leaders.

WLN Events

521 women and men attended **virtual events** hosted by the Canadian, Eastern, Hartford, Mid-Atlantic, and New England Chapters.



The PLUS Foundation hosted the **WLN Luncheon** at the PLUS Conference in Dallas. Michelle King, an expert on gender equality and organizational culture, spoke about creating workplace cultures that work for everyone.

WLN Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to promising female leaders who seek to advance their education and career. Recipients receive up to \$5,000 for leadership programs, are paired with a mentor, get involved in regional WLN events, and are offered opportunities to network with PLUS and PLUS Foundation leaders.
